



FREDCAMP 2019

June 30 - July 6, 2019

FredCamp is an ecumenical Christian workcamp for high school youth working to repair hearts and homes in the Fredericksburg, Virginia area since 1999.

THE WORK

Campers repair ten pre-selected area homes. The residents pay nothing. Our work is a gift! Typical work projects may include drywall installation or patching, replacing flooring, painting, installing gutters, fixing porches, constructing wheelchair ramps. The possibilities are endless!

THE WORK CREWS

Each crew will consist of adults and youth from different churches. No specific skills are required to attend FredCamp, but skills or experience needed for certain jobs are taken into consideration when we form crews.

EVENING PROGRAMS

This type of experience can be life-changing; so, in the evening, we will creatively reflect on the day's activities, the week's theme and finding God in our experiences.

FREE TIME

Don't worry, there is daily free time to relax, enjoy some basketball, write a FredGram, or visit with FredCamp friends. On Wednesday, we'll take a well-deserved half-day break for special recreation activities! We plan to go tubing on the river!

TOOLS

Each camper is asked to bring at least two tools to share, in addition to tools they bring for personal use. Groups will be assigned tool marking colors so that tools can be sorted and returned. It's amazing that our community tool room usually provides just what we need to complete the week's work!

CAMPER REQUIREMENTS

Youth are 14 years of age (or entering the 9th grade) through youth that have just finished high school. Many campers return year after year, and are welcome to do so through the FredCamp year coinciding with their high school graduation. Adult campers are age 23 and up, and must be approved by their church to work with youth. FredCamp is a full-week retreat experience which demands complete commitment from every adult and youth camper. Commitment to the full camp week is expected from every camper. To maintain our adult-youth supervision and insurance requirements, your group must include at least one adult camper for every five youth campers. If your group has both male and female youth campers, it should also include both male and female adult campers. We ask adult campers to be prepared to provide transportation for a crew of 5 youth (and tools too), using their vehicle. Remember, adults attending are fully-participating work campers, too! OUR LODGING

For the entire week, we are lodged at Fredericksburg Christian High School, 9400 Thornton Rolling Road (just south of town off Route 17).

THE COST

The total cost is \$300 per youth camper and \$250 per adult camper. This covers everything: meals, housing, accident insurance, building materials for our work AND an official FredCamp T-shirt for each participant.

ADULT CAMPERS

Churches must submit a letter verifying all adult campers are approved to work with youth. Adult campers should provide copies of their driver's license and automobile insurance with their registration. We rely on adult campers to bring a vehicle to transport their crew of up to (5) youth.
